10. Start Registry Editor (Regedit.exe).

11. Locate and click the following key in the registry:

HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\System\CCSServices\AmdK7Parameters

12. On the Edit menu, point to New, click Dword Value, and then add the Value name: HackFlags

Radix: Hexadecimal

Value data: 1

A value of 1 enables the legacy Power Now! interface. To disable this feature

13. Quit Registry Editor.

14. Restart the computer.

You don't need windows drivers, which are out of date (at beginning of li AMD newest, yet still check the setting to 1 in registry edit will make Windows else to me it has appear to half work and slower as the AMD would fire up take ages to reassert where it was in the picture.
