We have Midrash saying that Simon left the original followers of Yeshua helped create a more Pharisaic Christianity.

If we understand we're meant to build upon the firm foundations of the R 7:24-26), and 'Simon followed man made doctrine more than God' (Matthewhere Yeshua called him 'satan', when he 'rebuked' what was prophesied (Zechariah 3:1-2).

The problem with people putting forward 'Precept upon Precept' in Isaiah Pharisaic ideas, is it's part of the Bed of Adultery from Isaiah 28:9-19.

Where the Pharisaic authors (John, Paul, Simon) created a Covenant with Corner Stone's (Messiah's) death being a payment to God; yet it was disconceived.
